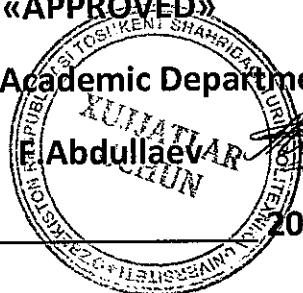

1. INTRODUCTION

The economics concerns to the fundamental category, as it gives the basic knowledge in the field of economy, forming students' outlook and ideology of national independence. This course is important for economic institutes because it opens access to understanding other economic courses.

The present curriculum on economics covers such problems as economic base of society, general principles and categories, essence of economic phenomena and processes, social economic systems and mechanism of their function, peculiarities of market economy establishment, social-economic reforms in transition period and their results, economic growth and factors which influence on it, the main tendencies of world economy development.

One of the major tasks of the course is to support students with deep and detailed knowledge of materials, ideas and conclusions of President of the republic of Uzbekistan I.A. Karimov's work "The world financial economic crises, the ways and arrangements for its overcoming in the condition of Uzbekistan", and effective use of obtained knowledge and creative approaches in solving economic questions.
